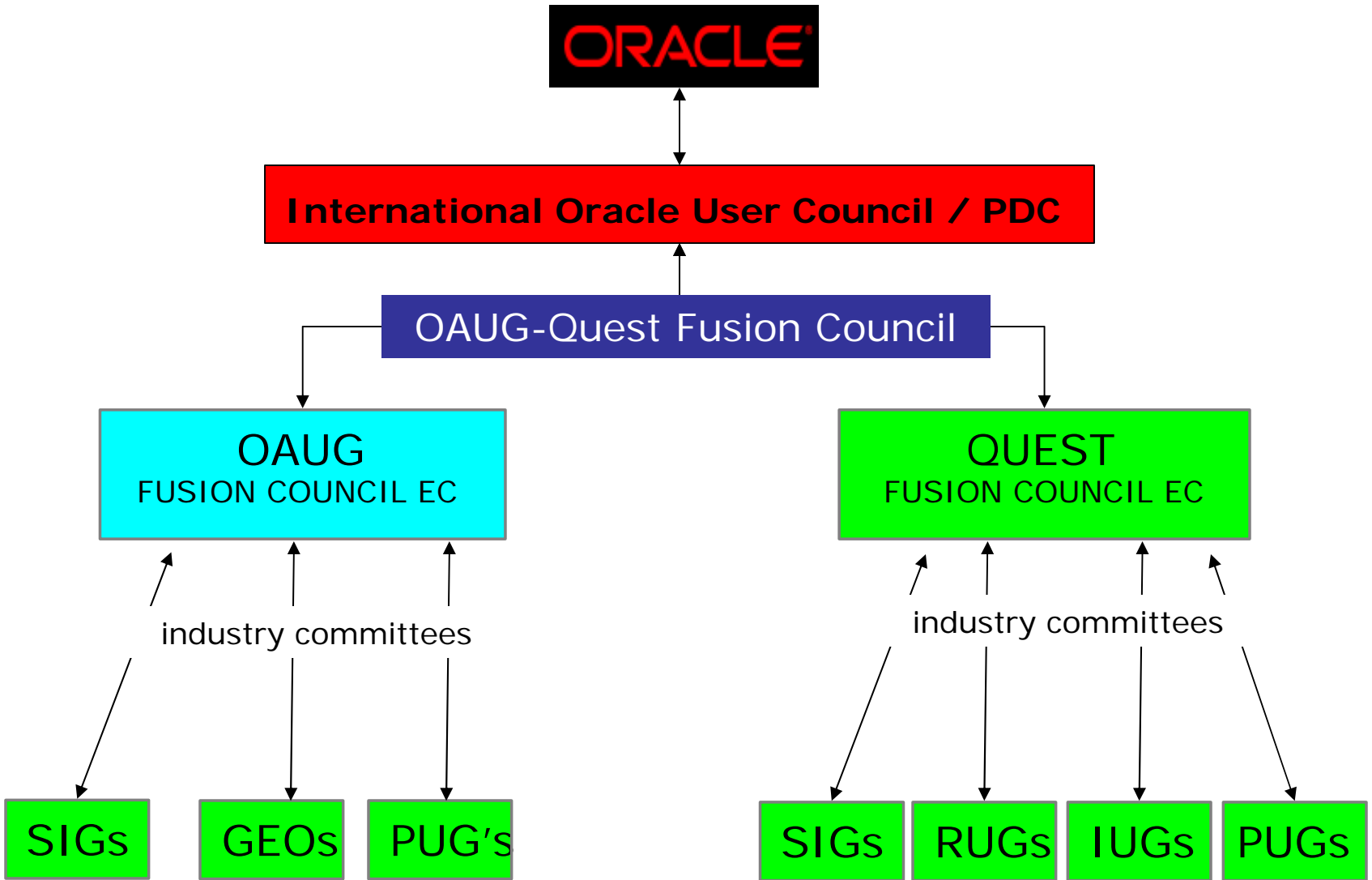

OAUG and Quest Fusion Efforts

OAUG and Quest each have ongoing, parallel Fusion efforts:

- **OAUG Fusion Council Executive Committee**
 - About 30 volunteers drawn from the OAUG membership and volunteers representing OAUG special interest groups.
 - Utilizes the OAUG Enhancement Request System
- **Quest Fusion Council Executive Committee**
 - About 30 volunteers drawn from the Quest membership and volunteers representing Quest special interest groups and regional, product and industry user groups.
 - Utilizes the Quest White Paper Process
- Work independently to collect, categorize and evaluate Fusion requirements
- Also work collaboratively to share information and cross-over Fusion input
- When the two organization-specific councils work together collaboratively, the collective group is known as the **OAUG-Quest Fusion Council**



International Oracle User Council / Product Development Committee

- Internationally active organization representing and promoting the collective interests of Oracle global user groups
- Quest and OAUG are two of the seven member organizations
- IOUC's Product Development Committee (PDC) looks after user group efforts to influence product development within Oracle
- Current PDC initiatives:
 - Fusion Channel
 - Identifying User Group nominations for Oracle Customer Advisory Boards (CABs)
